

# Dress Code 2015-2016

For the upcoming 2015-2016 School year we are <u>changing the dress code for Garner Elementary</u>.

Please read the criteria below regarding the dress code.

Student will receive 5 Incentive points each day they follow the Dress Code Guidelines.

## Bottoms:

- ONLY Tan/khaki or denim
- shorts, pants, skorts, skirts (must be mid-thigh or longer)
- must be plain, solid-color twill, corduroy or denim fabric
- appropriate sizes of clothing must be worn
- a belt is required if the bottoms have belt loops

## Tops:

- ONLY Hunter green, Navy shirt
- Garner Elementary's school hunter green ROAR shirt or last year's school navy blue or green shirt
- knit polo-type or woven dress shirts, turtlenecks
- must have long or short sleeves

#### Shoes:

- Must have a closed toe and closed heel (the toes and heels are not to be showing)
- Must be safe and appropriate (i.e., sneakers, gym shoes, tennis shoes)\
- Not acceptable: dress shoes, sandals or flip flops

## Any sweater, sweater vest, sweatshirt should:

- have a collar OR be worn with a collared uniform shirt or official school t-shirt underneath
- must not have any colored trim, stripes, sequence/glitter, etc. (small logos are OK)

# UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE.

- Students are <u>not allowed to wear clothing, jewelry, buttons, haircuts, or other attire or markings</u>, which are
  offensive, suggestive or indecent such as:
- Clothing associated with gangs, encouraging the use of drugs, alcohol, wrestling or violence
- Clothing exposing the torso or upper thighs such as see-through garments, mini-dresses, halters, backless dresses, tube tops or tank tops without over-blouses or shirts or blouses tied at the midriff
- Clothing not properly fastened or with tears which are indecent
- Athletic shorts, SWEAT OR JOGGING PANTS, including the spandex "bicycle" shorts, short shorts, and seethrough boxer-type shorts are not allowed
- Leggings and other form fitting stirrup pants are **not allowed**.

## **Parent Portal**

Parents and guardians are able to access student information using the MyPolkSchools Parent Portal. Below are the steps to access the information:

- 1. Obtain the secret personal identification number for each of your students by visiting his or her school and filling out the Parent/Guardian PIN Request Form for Access to Parent Portal form.
- 2. Create a Polk-ID account (if you don't already have one) by visiting www.polkschools.net
- 3. Attach the student(s) to your Polk-ID account by following the on-screen instructions after Step Two.
